



Scott Community Foundation Scholarships offered to K-State Global Campus Degree Seeking Students

Many of our best and brightest community members, whether they are recent graduates or middle-aged adults, want to remain in the Scott County area. At the same time, they wish to enrich their personal lives and enhance their professional development by receiving a college degree or certificate. Scott Community Foundation has partnered with Kansas State University Global Campus to provide scholarships to distance education students living and working in Scott County. Through a partnership between the Scott Community Foundation and Kansas State University Global Campus, local Scott County citizens can complete their bachelor or graduate-level degree online or pursue an online certificate program. This allows individuals to obtain their educational goals while remaining in the community.

Scholarships are available to both undergraduate and graduate students in the amount of \$1,000.

Scholarship Criteria

- The student will have a minimum 3.0 GPA in current or previous college coursework.
- The student will be a resident of the Scott Community Foundation service area
- The student will be admitted to a K-State Global Campus program and must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credit hours during the term for which the scholarship is received.

Scholarship Deadlines

- There is no deadline for this scholarship – applications are available year-round.
- Note: Recipients of this scholarship may reapply for subsequent terms.

Fund Disbursement

The Community Foundation will disburse the scholarship award to the Kansas State University Office of Financial Aid and the amount will be credited to the student's account.
